

Internship in Germany at Paderborn University

Open to: Graduate and undergraduate students from the fields of cultural studies, arts and humanities, social studies, literature, German/English studies, other philologies and teacher education programs.

Application deadline: April 15th for an internship ca. 15th of Sept – 15th of Dec (fall term in Alberta)
October 15th for a start date ca. 1st of May – End of July (summer term in Alberta)

Duration: 3-4 months
Working hours: to be agreed upon/flexible working hours
Housing and transport: Student dormitories; free semester ticket for state-wide public transportation
Additional offers: Free German language classes, reduced meal costs, optional social activities and weekend trips to German cities or cultural activities; Certification and reference letter from Paderborn University guaranteed

About the internship: Paderborn University is home to 17.500 students and 2.000 employees. The Faculty of Arts and Humanities is the largest of 5 faculties with 7.500 students. The research fields range from English and American Studies, Education Science, Arts, Philosophy, Psychology, Sociology, Music, Theology, History, Media Studies, Romance Studies (French and Spanish languages) to the Study of the German language.

The internship at the Psychology Department (Division: Psychological assessment and intervention; <https://kw.uni-paderborn.de/en/subject-psychology/educational-psychological-assessment-and-intervention>) will comprise an independent yet supervised research study in the field of either procrastination research, evaluation of psychological interventions, or validation of psychological assessment tools. If you are interested in fostering your knowledge and skills within any of those areas, we would be happy to receive an application from you.

Requirements:

- Student at one of the Canadian universities within the Alberta-OWL-Cooperation: University of Alberta, MacEwan University, Northern Alberta Institute of Technology, Concordia University of Edmonton
- At least one year of study left at home institution
- Interest in psychological research (quantitative or qualitative research methods)
- Basic knowledge of empirical research methods including the application of statistical analysis programs
- Interest in German higher education system

- Soft skills: open communication, social skills, ability to work in a team, ambition to actively participate and engage in internship
