- School Intern (As an integrated part of the internship): Gain experience by completing an internship at "Goerdeler Gymnasium" a local secondary school (years 5 to 13)
- In Germany, pupils attend classes in English as a foreign language (EFL) starting in elementary school. Therefore, our students are well equipped with theoretical knowledge of English. To further improve their language proficiency, a steady immersion in the language is paramount. As a native speaker you will be a great addition to our team of English school teachers, adding a different perspective and allowing cooperative teaching methods in the EFL-classroom.
- Your tasks include but are not limited to: assisting the English teachers in the preparation of lessons, team-teaching, giving individual language support to students and much more
- The school offers a variety of other subjects as well as extracurricular activities which you are welcome to attend and be a part of.

## Requirements:

- Student at one of the Canadian universities within the Alberta-OWL-Cooperation: University of Alberta, MacEwan University, Northern Alberta Institute of Technology, Concordia University of Edmonton from a teacher education program or similar studies
- At least one year of study left at home institution
- Interest in an intercultural exchange with German students



- Interns must be fully vaccinated against Measles for school placement
- Soft skills: open communication, social skills, ability to work in a team, ambition to actively participate and engage in internship
