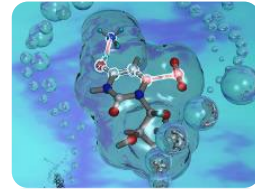
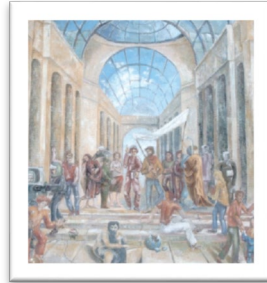

- Teaching Assistant at one of the chairs of our faculty
- Student or research assistant to a chair within our faculty;
- Intern at e.g. the Center for Gender Studies, English and American
- Department or another institution/department at our faculty;
- Intern at a local school

- Support with dormitory accommodation
- Free German language course offers
- Free choice from all courses from the complete course catalogue** (<https://paul.uni-paderborn.de/>)
- Extensive course offers in English
- Buddy program (initial support program during arrival and first days in Paderborn)
- Cultural orientation program (Intercultural Training, cultural events, day and weekend trips)
- Free usage of public transportation within the state of North-Rhine-Westphalia with the semester ticket for around €300* per semester

Enrollment as Exchange Students

Requires payment of administrative semester fee (ca. 300* Euro), but offers many advantages:

- Entry into Germany for 90 days without visa for Canadian citizens or with study visa (if required - see [visa navigator](#) of the Federal Foreign Office)
- Work permission: International students in Germany are permitted to work 120 full days or 240 half days per year
- Reduced meal costs at university
- Semester ticket, currently includes „Deutschlandticket“ which allows free public transport throughout Germany
- Dormitory Accommodation (ca. 350 – 380 Euro per month*, 4 months rent minimum)
- Access to campus management system PAUL, also required to register for our free German language courses for exchange students
- Library access
- Notebook Cafe access (free IT support and advice)
- Accident insurance during study or student work related activities at University (until the age of 30)
- Health insurance required – must be paid from the start of the semester, but can be cancelled on the day of departure (before semester ends)
